HIGH SCHOOL COURSE OFFERINGS	Mr. Neely presented a review of the requirement for all students to take college prep classes. Following a review of statistical data, he outlined proposed next steps:	
	 Eliminate the requirement for all students to take college prep classes; Improve the ability to process and use data; Immediately institute a K-12 philosophy based on early evaluation and intervention; Increase emphasis on meaningful CTE education; Take ownership of the problem.
