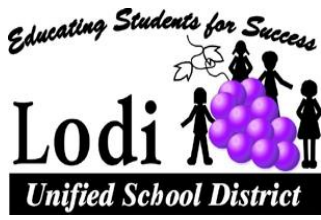
Reading and Approval of Minutes:
