EMERGENCY ALERT SYSTEM (EAS) RADIOS

In 2008, all District sites were equipped with EAS Radios. These radio receivers are typically located in central administrative areas where they can be easily accessed and should be frequently monitored. The EAS Radio provides weather, child adduction, civil emergency, national emergency action, immediate evacuation, and other emergency notification, which therefore should always be in fully operational condition.

To assist you with ensuring that this critical site safety device is working properly, the Office of Emergency Services (OES) conducts weekly system tests typically between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm on Wednesdays. Make sure that the EAS Radio is activated and the volume adjusted so that alert messages can be immediately received.
