Group	Requirement
Persons Who Test Positive for COVID-19	 Stay home for at least 5 days. Isolation can end after day 5 if symptoms are not present or are resolving and a diagnostic specimen* collected on day 5 or later tests negative. If unable to test or choosing not to test, and symptoms are not present or are resolving, isolation can end after day 10. If fever is present, isolation should be continued until fever resolves. If symptoms, other than fever, are not resolving continue to isolate until symptoms are resolving or until after day 10. Wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings (see Section below on masking for additional information) *Antigen test preferred.
 Exposure to Someone with COVID-19 Unvaccinated persons; OR Vaccinated and booster-eligible persons but have not yet received their booster dose.** **(Refer to CDC COVID-19 Booster Shots to determine who is booster eligible). 	In a workplace setting, exposed but asymptomatic employees who are unvaccinated, vaccinated and booster eligible but not yet boosted, and anyone who had confirmed COVID19 within last 90 days are not required to stay home from work if: • A negative diagnostic test is obtained within 3-5 days after last exposure to a case. • Employee wears a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days. • Employee continues to have no symptoms. If person cannot/will not test, ten (10) day quarantine applies.
Persons Who are Exposed to Someone with COVID-19	 Test on day 5. Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days, especially in indoor settings (see Section below on masking for additional information) If testing positive, follow isolation recommendations above. If symptoms develop, test and stay home.
Symptomatic Persons	 Stay home Test Positive test, follow protocol above Negative test, return to work when symptoms improve and no sign of fever

Exposure is defined as being within 0 -6 feet of a laboratory-confirmed COVID19 case for greater than 15 minutes in the aggregate over a 24-hr period.
