Elementary Textbook Information and Guidelines

Lodi Unified School District takes every precaution to maintain the integrity of the textbooks that we “loan” our students each school year. We expect our students and parents to help us protect our textbooks.

Textbooks are usually issued within the first 10 days of the school year and returned within the last 10 days of ending the school year. Your child will be issued a hardbound core subject textbook which will consist of English (Gr.1-6), Math (Gr.6), Science (Gr.2-6), and History (Gr.3-6). Some children may receive textbooks for an Intervention class as well. All textbooks are costly, ranging in replacement value from \$53.00 - \$110.00*. The textbooks are considered a “loan” and will be returned at the end of the school year; however, if your child loses his/her textbook (or damages the textbook beyond repair) you will be responsible for the replacement cost of the text.

Your child will receive his/her own personal workbooks for the subjects mentioned above. The District provides the first workbook at no cost to your child and does not need to be returned; however, if your child loses his/her workbook, you will be responsible for the cost of any replacement workbooks. The workbooks range in value from \$3.00 - \$36.00.*

- Student will treat all textbook materials with respect.
- Student textbook materials have a barcode that become specific to each student’s record.
- Student is responsible for the condition of and the return of his/her “barcode specific” textbook materials.
- Student upon receiving textbook materials shall immediately report any “issues” (markings, torn pages, moisture damage) regarding these materials to the school staff.
- Student should never leave his/her textbook materials with another student, with a teacher, or leave them unattended.
- Student defacing (removal of barcode, permanent markings, torn pages, moisture damage) of textbook materials shall be charged the replacement value of the materials and will be billed to the parent/legal guardian.
- Student shall return their textbook materials on their scheduled return day toward the end of the school year.
- Student with overdue and/or textbook fines may result in consequences (i.e.; exempt from extra-curricular activities, dances, etc.).
