1.9 Question: (Christa McAuliffe Middle School Paving Phase II) Per demolition plan sheet C1.1, some of the islands show concrete curb removal, but do not have call outs associated. Please clarify that the only curb to be removed/ installed is the curb around the northwest island, only around the area where the ADA stall is to be installed and where the call outs are associated to the dashed line.

Response: Yes, only the curb shown at the ADA stalls are to be removed.

1.10 Question: (Christa McAuliffe Middle School Paving Phase II) Per grading plan sheet C2.1 and paving plan sheet C3.1 (at the new sidewalk improvements to the northwest), there is a callout for 6" barrier curb to be placed where an existing curb and gutter is located. The demolition plan sheet C1.1 does not show the limits of curb and gutter removal to the extent of the new 6" barrier curb installation. Please confirm a 6" curb and gutter per detail 6 on C3.1 is not to be placed in lieu of the 6" curb that is shown in areas that contain an existing curb and gutter.

Response: The note 11 barrier curb is to be constructed behind the existing curb and gutter. Where note 15 is shown it is to replace the existing curb and gutter.

1.11 Question: (Christa McAuliffe Middle School Paving Phase II) Per demolition plan sheet C1.1, the existing striping is not shown to be removed. Please confirm the existing striping does not need to be removed in any way prior to seal coat.

Response: The striping does not need to be removed. It is being restriped in the current configuration.
