Students

District Residency

Prior to admission, students living within the district must provide proof of residency.

A student may establish residency by documenting that he/she lives with a parent/guardian within the district, is an emancipated minor living in the district, is in the court-appointed care of a licensed foster home, family home, or children's institution within the district, or lives in the home of a care-giving adult within the district.
