NO USE MESSAGE FOR TOBACCO, ALCOHOL AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

Lodi Unified School District recognizes that substance abuse has the capacity to destroy students' lives; it recognizes also that substance abuse is a problem of our society which adversely affects students' ability to achieve to their highest potential.

Our school supports the family in reinforcing a strong message to young people for "no use" of tobacco, alcohol and controlled substances. Consequently, the use or possession of tobacco, alcohol, or controlled substances by students and adults is prohibited at any Lodi Unified School District site or activity. Further, any attire/paraphernalia/symbol that displays a logo or other message relating to alcohol, tobacco, or a controlled substance may not be worn on campus or at school related activities.

GRADES 9-12 ALCOHOL AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE POLICY

TO POSSESS, USE OR BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE AND/OR ANY CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE

CONSEQUENCES:

Minimum: Five (5) day suspension, forty-five (45) school day social probation,* and give (5) hours of substance abuse counseling.**

Maximum: Five (5) day suspension, recommendation for expulsion, notice to law enforcement.

***Social Probation Definition:**

Student on Social Probation may not attend any school related event for forty-five (45) school days. A school related event is any school sponsored activity that occurs outside of regular school hours. School related events include, but are not limited to, participation in or attendance at school sponsored athletic events, band, choir, drama, cheer, drill or speech performances, school dances, after school rallies, student government, club activities.

****Substance Abuse Counseling:**

Students must attend five (5) hours of any combination of the following: Private Counseling; Public Counseling; District approved Substance Abuse Counseling. Any associated costs will be the responsibility of the student and parent Failure to attend

the five (5) hours of Substance Abuse counseling will result in an extension of the Social Probation until the five (5) hours are completed.
