## Policy 6116

### Instruction

#### Classroom Interruptions

The Board of Education recognizes that student instructional time is the most valuable resource offered by the school district and that frequent interruptions in the classroom are detrimental to the instructional program.

In order that students and teachers may take full advantage of classroom time, the Superintendent is charged with the responsibility of ensuring that classroom interruptions shall be kept to an absolute minimum and, other than in emergency situations, shall be scheduled to occur at time that are the least disruptive to the instructional program.
