Energy Conservation

The Board of Education is committed to adopting an energy conservation plan that will result in a significant reduction in energy consumption. Every student and employee will be expected to contribute to energy efficiency in the District and will be responsible for implementing the following guidelines in classroom, offices, and other work areas as appropriate. The Board of Education is also committed to provide the necessary resources to ensure that proper maintenance is done on all energy consuming equipment and that all energy consuming equipment is comprised of the most efficient technology.

To this end, the District shall practice preventive maintenance and monitoring for its facilities and systems, including heating, ventilation and air-conditioning (HVAC), building envelope and moisture management. Accountability and monitoring for energy management at all sites shall be conducted regularly and will be based on regular energy audits that measure the successful implementation of conservation efforts.
